At the sprint review, working functionality, and only production quality working functionality may be demonstrated

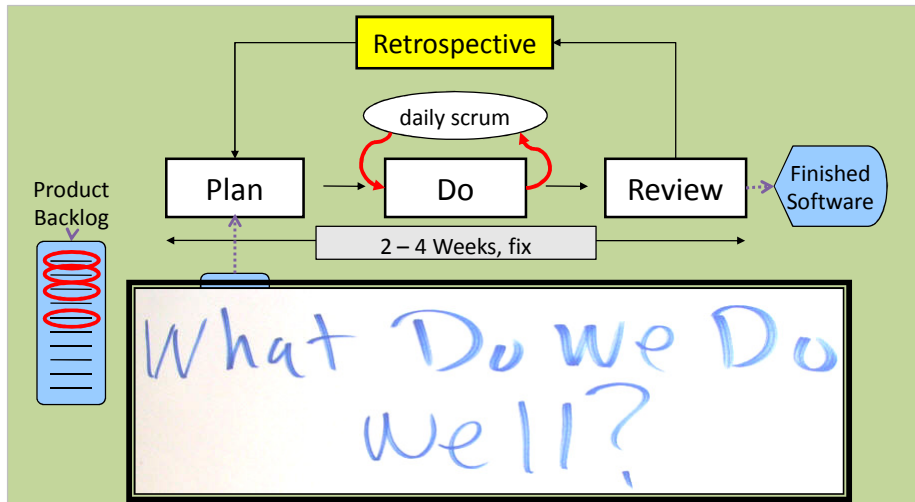

After each sprint, the team identifies and prioritizes potential improvements, and implements the most important.



Simple artifacts ensure that everyone understands the state of the project and what they have to do.



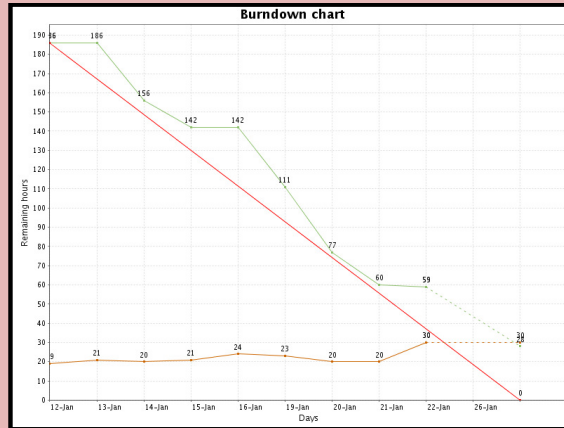

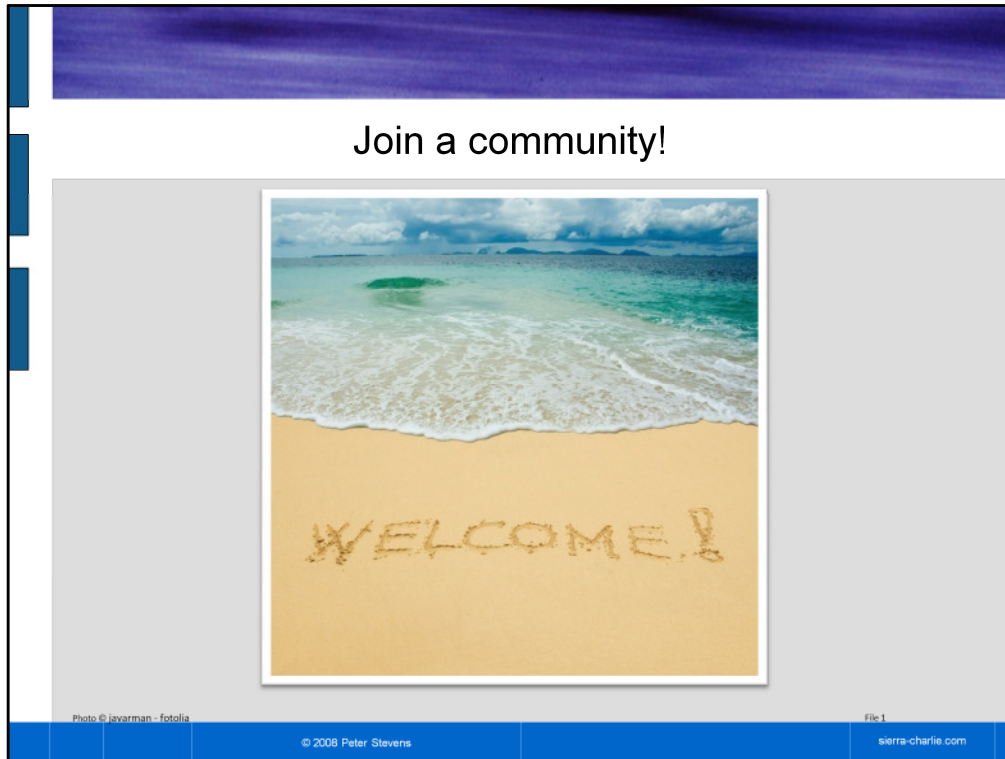

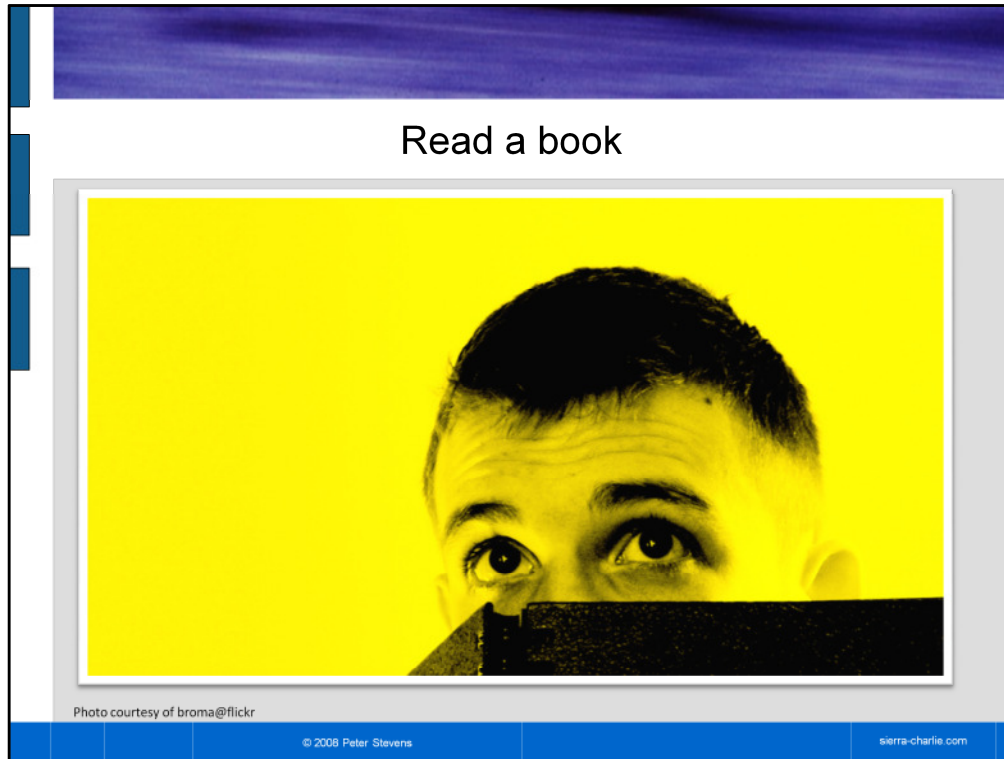

## Do's & Don't

### Do's

- Large companies
  - Get a Coach
  - Get Training for you and your team
  - Get Management Support
- Anybody
  - Respect the sprint contract
  - Respect self organization
  - Retrospective every sprint
  - Short sprints (2-3 weeks)

### Dont's

- Large Companies
  - Try "Stealth" Scrum
- Anybody
  - Refuse to compromise
  - Stop learning
  - Change Scrum (before you have mastered it)
